!!Resource Promotion Night!! Displacement Ventilation

This month our meeting will be held at **The Abbey Hotel**. The Board of Govenors has designated this month's meeting as Resource Promotion Night.

This month's meeting includes a presentation on Displcement Ventilation by Andrey Livchak of the Halton Company.

Mr. Livchak is the Director of Research for the Halton Company. He graduated from Moscow Civil Engineering University and worked in research and development in different HVAC disciplines including heat recovery, water heating systems, air distribution and acoustics in Russia. He joined Halton in 1990 first working in R&D in Finland and since 1998 leads the new Innovation Center in the USA focusing on the development of Displacement Ventilation systems and ventilation solutions for commercial kitchens.

He is the voting member of ASHRAE Technical Commtee 5.3 (Room Air Distribution). He has 19 publications (including 4 recent publications on Displacement Ventilation) and 8 patents.
