Professional Energy Code Seminar - ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1-2004

ENERGY STANDARD FOR BUILDINGS EXCEPT LOW-RISE RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS

This month our meeting is a full day seminar held at the Mark in Moline, IL. The seminar is jointly sponsored by our chapter and the State of Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. This is a great opportunity to learn more about ASHRAE 90.1-2004 and the new Illinois Energy Efficiency Code for all commercial buildings that will be enforced in the Spring of 2006. Seminar speakers are Lawrence Spielvogel, Leonard Sciarra, and Jerry White.

Mr. Spielvogel is an ASHRAE Fellow and now chairs the ASHRAE Homeland Security Committee and serves on the ASHRAE Nominating, Finance, and Advocacy Committees. He previously chaired the ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1 Project Committee, ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 105 on Building Energy Performance, the Standard 90 Panel on HVAC Systems, and ASHRAE technical committees on energy utilization, computer applications, and service water heating.

Mr. Sciarra is a project architect at Serena Sturm Architects with experience on large and small-scale projects with a variety of project types and is involved in all phases of construction from Pre-Design to Post Construction. With a background in sustainable and environmental design, Mr. Sciarra served as Co-Chair of the Chicago AIA Committee on the Environment, is a LEED Accredited Professional, and is a member of the ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1 Committee.
